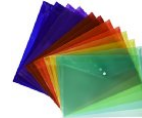

IF we pool our cash and order from different places we should be able to only spend \$65 per child

Any supplies purchased directly by the parent need to be at the school by Thursday before the 1st day of school, during pre-planning. So they don't lose teaching time the 1st week going through supplies. Contributing \$65 directly to the OPPA Elementary account will allow materials that have a shelf life to be purchased later in the year, not to mention easier on the parent. This account is also part of OPPA so your donation would be tax deductible since it is not going to a specific child but the general use of the class.

We are working to get your snack money applied this way, for both the tax benefit of the parent, and also because this account is the Elementary's and can be used in lessons so they see where their money is going, and how better to budget.
